A switch-out or a withdrawal under SWP shall also attract an Exit Load like any Redemption.

The above provisions shall be effective from June 25, 2010 and applicable on prospective investments only. This addendum should be read with, and forms an integral part of; the Scheme Information Document (SID) and Key Information Memorandum (KIM) of the JPMorgan India Active Bond Fund and may not be distributed without the SID or KIM.
